Human Rights and Fair Labour

We uphold internationally recognised human rights throughout our operations and supply chains. We:

- Prohibit the use of forced labour, child labour, and all forms of modern slavery.
- Respect the rights of workers to fair wages, safe working conditions, and freedom of association.
- Conduct due diligence on key suppliers to identify and manage social risks.
